

- WHEREAS, in 2010, communities situated along the east and west shorelines of Narragansett Bay aligned to form the "Congress of Councils" to fight the proposed Weaver's Cove Energy LNG terminal to be built in Mt. Hope Bay in Fall River, Massachusetts, by the Hess Corporation; and
- WHEREAS, on September 9, 2010, the inaugural meeting of the "Congress of Councils," with representatives of the Councils of the City of Newport and the Towns of North Kingstown, Jamestown, Middletown, Portsmouth, Little Compton, and Warren, as well as Fall River, MA, was held in Jamestown, with the goal of formulating a strategic plan to prevent the development of the LNG facility; and
- WHEREAS, a second meeting of the Congress of Councils was held on February 16, 2011, in Fall River, MA.
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT
- RESOLVED: that the Council of the City of Newport host the third meeting of the Congress of Councils and extend invitations to the participating councils, town managers and town solicitors, and other interested communities, so as to continue momentum in the fight against the LNG facility and the development of a strategic plan.
