Petition to File Will with No Assets

This is a new form created to allow an executor to file a will with the Probate Court when there is no probate administration required.

This form is an affidavit of no probate. This form is completed by the Executor and witnessed by a notary. It is provided to the Court by the Executor. The Executor is requesting to file the deceased's will and states that there are no assets which require administration.

The Executor presents for filing:

- The completed form.
- Original Will
- Certified Death Certificate

The Probate Clerk:

- Enters form in court records.
- Collects fee.
