This form is a Statutory form.

- This form is a means by which a qualified Fiduciary provides notice to a reasonably known (or easily ascertained) creditor that probate on an estate has begun.
- The sending of this form to a creditor at his/her last known address, by first class mail, postage prepaid, is a means (but not an exclusive means) of satisfying this requirement.

The Attorney or Fiduciary:

- Prepares the form for mailing.

The Probate Clerk:

- Enters copies of form in the Court files.
