NEW BUSINESS

- 1) Farmland Acquisition re: request for authorization for the Town Council President to sign the deed for development rights for farmland acquisition.

Following a review of the resolution to authorize the Town Council President to sign the deeds of development rights for the Dutra and Neale Farms, it was moved by Councilor Schnack, seconded by Councilor Kelly to adopt Resolution 07-027 as follows:

A resolution authorizing the Council President to sign the Deed to Development rights for the protection and preservation of approximately 80 acres of the Dutra farm located on Weeden Lane, Jamestown, to sign the Deed to Developments Rights RI. Said Deed of Development Rights shall be executed in partnership with the United States Department of Agriculture, the State of Rhode Island Agricultural Land Preservation Commission, and the Conanicut Island Land Trust.

A resolution authorizing the Council President to sign the Deed to Development rights for the protection and preservation of approximately 39 acres of the Neale farm located on Weeden Lane, Jamestown, RI.. Said Deed of Development Rights shall be executed in partnership with the United States Department of Agriculture, the State of Rhode Island Agricultural Land Preservation Commission, and the Conanicut Island Land Trust.

So unanimously voted.

There being no further business before the Council, it was moved by Councilor Schnack, seconded by Council President Long to adjourn the meeting at 4:39 p.m.
