

WOULD YOU LIKE A FREE TREE

Did you know that Jamestown has a tree-planting program where homeowners can have a tree planted in front of their house for free?



The tree will be planted within the Town's right of way, which is usually about ten feet off the shoulder of the road.

What types of trees are available? Click on Jamestown Tree Selection at the Jamestown Tree Committee's web site or obtain a hard copy at the Town Clerk's office. Choose a species from this list. The Tree Warden will work with the homeowner to select a tree that will enhance both their home and the street with aesthetic quality. If there are overhead utility lines, a tree that matures at a low height must be selected.

The Highway Department and the Tree Warden will plant the tree in either the spring or the fall planting program. The homeowner must accept responsibility to water and care for the tree. If interested, please complete and mail in this form.
